Non Breeding Agreement

This contract is entered into between DJ'S AUSSIE KENNEL , hereinafter known as the BREEDER and _____ hereinafter know as the buyer.

This is in agreement that the Buyer is purchasing said dog described below

This is an agreement that the above dog is sold as a pet only and is not for breeding. The above dog is to be surgically altered at an age of no more than 8 months. Before the dog is surgically altered the dog is not to be allowed to breed, be bred, or in any way produce a litter of puppies.

When the puppy has been altered I must receive a certificate of alteration from the vet who performed the procedure. I reserve the right to contact your vet to ensure the procedure has been accomplished. When the vet has verified your statement I will send you your registered papers for the puppy. The papers will remain in my care until the puppy has been altered. If you so decide not to alter your puppy I have the right to take the puppy into my care at buyers expense long enough to have him/her altered at buyers expense. The puppy will not return to the buyers care until all of the expenses have been payed in full.

The word DJ'S must appear somewhere in your puppies new name on his/her papers. This is a way of me tracking my own stock for breeding in the future. As well once the puppy has been altered I the breeder require three pictures. One profile each standing of both side as well as a front shot standing. To keep in my files.

If said dog is allowed to breed, be bred, or in any way produce a litter of puppies the Buyer's ownership is immediately revoked. Dog is to be returned to Breeders. If dog is found with reasonable proof to have been bred, done a breeding or in any way produced a litter of puppies, breeders have the right to enter buyers property and reclaim said dog immediately at no cost to breeders if buyers refuse to return said dog. Any costs incurred will be at the expense of the buyer.

If this is a female dog, the litter will be aborted immediately upon awareness that she is pregnant. She will then be returned to the breeders at the buyers' expense. She will become the property of the breeders to keep or re-homed as breeders' see fit. If she has had puppies, they also become the property of the breeders to home as they see fit. If this is a male dog, he is to be returned immediately to breeders at the expense of the buyers. If buyers must come and claim said dog, then all costs are at the expense of the buyers. If the female he was bred to belongs to buyer, she is to have an abortion immediately.

If said dog is found to have been bred, allowed to breed, or in any way produce a litter of puppies. The clubs registering Miniature Australian Shepherds will be notified and no puppies (if pure bred) will be eligible for registration.

Other breeders will be notified of the breach of contract to protect our breed from reproducing when we do not deem of high enough quality to breed.

The puppy must be entered into at least one puppy class for obedience. This is an excellent form of socialization and training for you and your new puppy. To be completed before six mnths of age,

Royal Canin puppy food is the recommend food of choice for you new pet until the puppy is a least 10mnths of age. If you decide not to keep the choice that I have provided a higher end puppy food such as Technical or Nutro Natural Choice must be fed to said puppy until 10mnths of age. After this time the puppy can be switched to adult food. Raw food diet is also acceptable. If you at any time feed your puppy lower end food such as puppy chow or other no name generic food to said puppy the two year genetic health guarantee becomes null and void!! If any questions or concerns about what you would like to feed please contact the breeder and ask before feeding said puppy the new choice of food. It is in the breeders opinion that these lower end foods offer little to no nutritional value to the meet the puppies ever changing needs.

Said puppy is not transferable. If you decide that you are no longer are able to care for said puppy. He/she is to be returned to the breeders to place in a new home as we see fit. If you do know of one that is acceptable to our standards please let us know and it would be considered. This puppy/dog is NEVER to be turned into the Humane Society for any reason or tied outside unattended. If either of these are done you are in breach of this contract and by doing this give up all rights to said puppy/dog.

This agreement is mutually stipulated to have been entered into Napanee, Ontario, Canada, regardless of the place where it is signed. The buyer and breeder agree that the proper venue

for any legal action taken to enforce the terms and conditions of this agreement shall be in the county of the breeders residence and that this agreement shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the province of Ontario. In the event that legal action is taken to enforce the terms of this agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to an award of attorneys' fees and costs. This contract is binding in the province of Ontario and is non-transferable unless agreed to by both parties.
